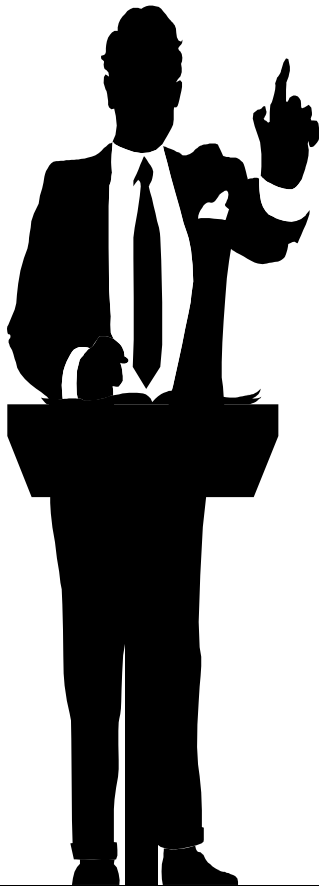

Discussion relating to the biomechanical, residual and developmental effects of pronation on children with low muscle tone will introduce a functional approach to evaluating, analyzing and managing this population through orthotic intervention. Attendees will leave with new strategies to assist with creating a cooperative approach to assist and compliment the therapeutic and functional goals set forth by the therapy team. **3:30 – 5:30 Stance Phase Locking Orthotic Knee Joint (SPL-2) A Clinical 'Best Practices' program / Fillauer - John Schulte, CPO, FAAOP;** Many new Orthotic solutions are being developed that lock the Orthosis selectively during gait. This enables desired dynamic motion within the Orthosis but creates new structural and kinetic challenges to Orthotic design and clinical optimization. Lecture will examine solutions that enable the practitioner to provide controlled motion of the LE knee joint during gait rather than Joint locking. This program includes a number of pertinent patient case studies. Interactive discussions will enable the attendee to make clinically informed decisions relative to patient criteria, component selection and design of this newly designed device. *This Multi-media Best Practices interactive presentation utilizes lecture, slides and printed materials.*
